Emergency procedures

If This Happens	Do This
Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic, check for spills or leaks. If possible contain with earth or other inert material.
Spill or leak	Turn off power at mains before attempting working in the area. Wear protective clothing. If practical, prevent further leakage. Contain spill, recover and consult your local body for disposal. Small quantities may be diluted and washed to sewer.
Fire	This product does not support combustion. It may burn or give off choking fumes if involved in a major fire. Use water, foam, CO ₂ , or dry powder to extinguish, depending on the other components in the fire.

First Aid

Health Effect	Acid, corrosive. Dangerous if swallowed. Causes serious eye and skin damage. Avoid skin contact or inhalation of mists or aerosols. May cause an allergic reaction in sensitive individuals.
Swallowed	Call a Doctor. Wash out mouth and give a glass or two of water or milk. DONT cause vomiting unless medical assistance is delayed by 30 minutes (take care to avoid patient inhaling the stomach contents). If breathing stops start mouth-to-nose resuscitation
Eyes	Wash eye with gently running water for at least 20 minutes. Dont rub the eye. Lightly cover the eye with a sterile dressing. Transport to hospital.
Skin	Wash contaminated skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If swelling, redness, blistering, or irritation occurs seek medical advice.
Inhaled	Remove the casualty to fresh air and away from further contamination. Wash face and mouth with water. If breathing stops start mouth-to-nose resuscitation. Arrange urgent transport to hospital.
