DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Keep container closed when not in use. The Ethanol will start to evaporate and dry once the seal is broken. Dry wipes are not suitable for use. FIL Milker's Wipes are for cleaning and disinfecting teats prior to taking samples for bacteriological culture using aseptic techniques, prior to intramammary administration of antibiotics, dry cow therapy or when treating heifers in preparation of first milkings.

1. Use a new wipe for each teat/quarter.
2. Scrub the teat until the wipe comes away clean, focusing on the teat end. Use as many wipes needed to achieve this.
3. If teats are heavily contaminated or dirty, wash and dry prior to cleaning with FIL Milker's Wipes.
4. Ensure the teat is dry before administering intramammary products.
5. Ensure teats are dry prior to attaching milking clusters if milking cows following using FIL Milker's Wipes.

HAZARD

PREVENTION

Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking. Keep container tightly closed. Ground and bond container and receiving equipment. Use explosion-proof electrical/ventilating/lighting/intrinsically safe equipment. Use non-sparking tools. Take action to prevent static discharges. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection and face protection. Wash all exposed external body areas thoroughly after handling.

RESPONSE

In case of fire: Use water jets to extinguish. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water (or shower).
