DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply as required.

HAZARD

Combustible liquid. May be harmful in contact with skin. May be harmful if inhaled. May be harmful if swallowed and enters airways. Causes skin irritation. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Harmful to aquatic life with long-lasting effects.

PREVENTION

Keep out of reach of children.
Read label and safety data sheet
before use. Keep away from open
flames and hot surfaces. No
smoking. Wear protective gloves/
protective clothing/eye protection/
face protection. Avoid release
to the environment. Wash hands
thoroughly after handling. Use only
outdoors in a well ventilated area.

RESPONSE

If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. In case of fire: Use water

fog or spray, foam or dry powder to extinguish. IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor; IF INHALED: Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor if you feel unwell. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Do NOT induce vomiting. If skin irritation occurs or eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

STORAGE

Store locked up in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of product and empty containers safely. Triple rinse containers when empty. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. Recycle empty container through Agrecovery (0800 247 326, www.agrecovery.co.nz).
